Grantees receiving Cultural Opportunity Grant funds are required to complete a report following the conclusion of their project. Collected information will be shared with the Oregon Cultural Trust—a requirement for LCCC’s continued ability to award grants—and will be utilized by LCCC to improve the grant process. Grantees must submit a complete and accurate report in order to be eligible for future funding.

Grant reports consist of the following two forms:

- Subgrant Report for the Oregon Cultural Trust; and
- LCCC supplemental questions, including a request for images of your project
